Dear Families,

We are sending this letter to all of our families because your child may be eligible for Supplemental Educational Services (SES). This after school tutoring program is available in reading and math and is offered at no cost to families that qualify.

To qualify for SES tutoring, you must meet the requirements for participating in the Free and Reduced Lunch program (FRLP). An application to apply for FRLP can be obtained by contacting Desiree Gunter at the School Office.

Families that do not qualify can also access some services for a small fee. Please contact Peg Jehle (jehelp@fcsuvt.org) or Sheryl Aliquo (aliquos@fcsuvt.org) at the school (527-0565 ext. 2211) for more information.

The tutoring will begin after school and a snack will be provided. Some of the options provide transportation for your child.

Parents of students that qualify can choose from different options for tutoring. A list of providers, and their qualifications, is available. You can get more information on our webpage sacsuvt.org, at the front desk or by calling us at the school and asking for Peg Jehle or Sheryl Aliquo. The SES tutoring program benefits your child by providing free instruction tailored to meet the individualized needs of your child.

Please contact the school to sign up your child for tutoring. This program is available to us because we remain a school in restructuring. There is a cap on the amount of money per student that we can spend on services. Once this amount has been reached, tutoring will end. Please contact Peg or Sheryl with any questions. We look forward to meeting you and supporting the educational needs of your child.
